

UNDERGRADUATE GLOBAL EXPERIENCE FUND SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Undergraduate Global Experiences Fund was established to provide financial support to undergraduates pursuing an international experience through a short academic program of study for credit led by a Stevens's faculty or staff member.

The Fund is created by gifts to Stevens from donors interested in supporting the participation of undergraduates in global experiences. Rules guide the management of the fund to ensure that its use is aligned with the wishes of the donors and with general gift stewardship constraints.

- Eligibility: Students participating in international programs, with defined and assessed educational outcomes and of at least two weeks duration, are eligible to apply. Shorter programs may be considered for eligibility based on the program's explicit, assessed educational outcomes and how these are addressed. Students in a traditional semester or academic year study abroad program are not eligible, nor are those receiving a Pinnacle Summer Scholarship.
- Use of Funds: Awards are intended to only assist with the travel and housing costs directly associated with the educational program; evidence (such as hotel receipts and tickets) to support such expenditures may be required on return.

Awards will be made only after the student has demonstrated a financial commitment to the International Program (e.g. purchasing a ticket or paying a non-refundable deposit). A student who does not fully participate in the program for which the award was provided or comply with "use of funds" requirements will be required to reimburse the Fund.

- Awards: Scholarship awards to eligible students are subject to availability of funds. Students with "high financial need", as determined by the Office of Financial Aid, have preference but it is not the only factor in determining the awards.
- **Donor acknowledgement:** Awardees are *required* to provide a personalized report to the Office of Development describing how the International Program benefited their education and *may* be asked to make a presentation to a donor(s) as acknowledgement of their support.
