1. **Non-Major Humanities-** Any four courses that count for humanities credit, including art history, with at least one 300-level or higher.

2. **All CAL students are required to take two courses in Math, one in Science and one in Computer Science.** Students may choose from CS 105, CS 115, or HAR 271 to fulfill the computer science requirement. 3. **General Electives** – chosen by the student – can be any approved 3 or 4 credit course used towards a minor, major concentration, research, independent study, language courses, or a course taken during an international experience.

4. **PE Requirement-** All students must complete a minimum of four semesters of Physical Education (P.E.) in non-repeating courses. No credit or grades are awarded for P.E. classes. Participation in varsity and club sports may be used to satisfy all four of the Physical Education requirements
