#### A Checklist of Application Requirements:

- Common Application
- Official high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation
- \$70 USD application fee
- Test scores (test optional for Fall 2023 first-year applicants)

### If electing to submit test scores, at least one of the following standardized test options is required:

- SAT I
- ACT
- Two AP exams: calculus and either chemistry or physics
- Two SAT subject tests: math and either chemistry or physics
- International Baccalaureate predicted grades with two higher-level exam scores in math and science

### If you are an international student applying to Stevens and English is not your first language, you must demonstrate English proficiency with one of the following:

- TOEFL (minimum score of 80 iBT)
- IELTS (minimum score of 6 overall)
- SAT I Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (minimum score of 550)
- Duolingo English Test (minimum score of 105)
- Pearson PTE Academic Test (minimum score of 53)
