

APPLICATION ESSENTIALS

A Checklist of Application Requirements:

- Common Application or Coalition Application
- Official high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation
- \$75 USD application fee
- Test scores - SAT/ACT (test optional for Fall 2026 applicants)



If you are an international student applying to Stevens and English is not your first language, you must demonstrate English proficiency with one of the following:

- TOEFL (*minimum score of 80 iBT*)
- IELTS (*minimum score of 6 overall*)
- SAT I Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (minimum score of 550)
- Duolingo English Test (*minimum score of 105*)

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

Apply by:

- **15 November** - Early Decision I
- **1 December** - Early Action
- **5 January** - Early Decision II
- **5 January** - Regular Decision
