An application is not required. Students who meet the following criteria will automatically be considered for a grant:

1. Enrolled in the 2020-2021 academic year as an undergraduate or full-time graduate student in a Stevens degree program.
 2. Have more than \$10,000 in original financial need, as calculated by the Stevens Cost of Attendance less the Expected Family Contribution (EFC), as calculated with information provided by the FAFSA.
 3. Priority will be given to students that have used available self-help aid and have maximized their federal student loan eligibi
- Grants are awarded in the following priority order until all available funds are expended:

1. Pell Grant recipients: \$1,000
2. Expected Family Contribution (EFC) between \$5,712 and \$20,000: \$750
3. Expected Family Contribution (EFC) between \$20,001 and \$30,000: \$500
4. Expected Family Contribution (EFC) greater than \$30,000 (until funds are expended): \$250
