To Faculty, Staff and Students:

This is a reminder to those voting in races across the country that deadlines for the November 2 elections are fast approaching. **In New Jersey, the deadline to register to vote is today, October 12.**

For those eligible to vote in New Jersey and Hoboken, it is an exciting and active ballot this year. In Hoboken, there is a mayoral election, and ten candidates are running for three at-large seats on the City Council. Statewide, every seat in the State Senate and Assembly is up for election in addition to the gubernatorial race.

Of course, to be eligible to participate in these elections, you must first be registered! You may register to vote in New Jersey via [this link](#). In New Jersey, you may also [vote early](#) or [vote by mail](#). In-person early voting locations will be open Saturday, October 23 through Sunday, October 31.

For those eligible to vote in Hoboken, on October 27 at 3 p.m., Stevens will be leading “Ducks to the Polls.” Stevens students and others who have registered to vote or with mail-in ballots will walk from Stevens’ campus to City Hall to cast their vote, followed by a celebration of democracy at Ben & Jerry’s.
