



GLOBAL AMBASSADORS PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION / TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Global Ambassador Program was developed for Stevens study abroad returnees who enjoyed their international experiences and now want to volunteer their time and effort to help other Stevens students find out about the many study abroad opportunities available to them. The Global Ambassadors are trained to help new students, explaining the type of program options, giving an overview of the study abroad process and, of course, talking about their own experiences. Global Ambassadors will need to be reachable via email and telephone. In summary, Global Ambassadors will:

- Lead study abroad presentations, drawing on personal experience
- Peer advise students on study abroad options
- Promote study abroad through special programs/events
- Refer students' specific questions regarding programs and procedure to the staff of the Office of International Programs

ROUTING OBLIGATIONS:

All Ambassadors are required to attend the following events / performing the following activities:

- One mandatory general training/reflection meeting per semester:
 - The first meeting (beginning of the semester: September or October/February) is a short training session where we present the Study Abroad procedure/process and other helpful tips.
- Assist in three study abroad events such as:
 - Study Abroad Fairs
 - Study Abroad Panels and Tables
 - Info Sessions (Wednesdays at 3pm) if it's related to where you studied abroad
 - Give two club presentations

We also encourage participation at any cross cultural/international events happening on campus or in the larger community. You do not have to work during these events, it is just a chance for you to meet other returnees and exchange students, and builds up your tool-kit for your Ambassador role and for your future professional path.

Benefits:

- 1) These presentations and sessions will help the study abroad returnees continue to “unpack” their study abroad experience, but also will allow them to fine tune their study abroad stories so they can add the skills they learned to their elevator pitch
- 2) OIP will for any volunteer hours for any clubs and organizations.
- 3) Study abroad sash at Graduation!
