Midpoint Review of Stevens Strategic Plan

Yesterday, President Farvardin charged the Strategic Plan Midpoint Review Steering Committee with the task of revising the university's 10-year strategic plan, *Stevens 2032: Inspired by Humanity, Powered by Technology*, for the years 2027-2032. It is our university's practice to update our strategic plan at its midpoint, in order to account for changes in our external environment, our internal operations, our challenges and successes to date and our more precise understanding of five-year outlook impacting our institution.

As co-chairs of the Strategic Plan Midpoint Review Steering Committee, we invite all members of our community to provide input into this process. Our goal is to collect input from the community and produce a draft that will be shared for feedback in time for review by the Stevens Board of Trustees at its December 2026 meeting. This aggressive timeline prepares us well for the visit by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education (MSCHE) to Stevens in Spring 2027.
