To All Faculty, Staff, and Students:

I am pleased to announce that we are approaching the final stages of the search process to identify the university's next provost and vice president for academic affairs. In light of current campus COVID-19 precautions, the typical two-day campus visit format has been modified to enable academic, administrative, and student leaders, as well as the larger campus community, to meet finalists via Zoom. These meetings are being held beginning **Thursday**, **April 8th and concluding on Friday**, **April 16th**.

A <u>secure site</u> has been created containing: each candidate's curriculum vitae; a link and password to participate in each candidate's Zoom-based presentation to the community; and a feedback survey. This secure site will be open only to those with valid Stevens credentials from 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 7th to 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 20th.

We encourage all community members who have the opportunity to meet with and/or participate in candidates' presentations to submit feedback via the online survey.

Please note that each of the finalists currently holds a senior academic position at an institution of higher education and requests that this campus-wide interview process remain confidential. Therefore, we ask that members of the Stevens community refrain from downloading candidate materials or discussing the identities of the candidates with those outside of Stevens.

Each finalist will give a brief presentation to the campus community on the following topic according to the schedule below. Please reserve these times and check the <u>secure site</u> for the link and password for each presentation.
