100.3 Policy on Personal Transportation Devices

I. <u>Purpose of this Policy</u>

The purpose of this Policy is to promote the safety of all faculty, staff, students and visitors to the Stevens campus. This Policy seeks to protect pedestrians and remove potential impediments to traffic flow on all property owned, leased or otherwise under the control of Stevens ("University Property").

II. <u>Policy</u>

The use of skateboards, scooters, roller skates, rollerblades, hoverboards or other personal transportation devices on University Property is prohibited. Non-motorized bicycles are not subject to this prohibition and may be used on University Property, provided that they are operated only on paved pathways at a safe speed and in a responsible and courteous manner.

Individuals who use skateboards, scooters, roller skates, rollerblades, hoverboards or other personal transportation devices on University Property, or operate a bicycle in violation of this Policy, will be subject to disciplinary action and/or other sanctions imposed by the Division of Student Affairs or the Division of Human Resources, as appropriate. Campus Police will report students violating this Policy to the Division of Student Affairs and will report faculty and staff violating this Policy to the Division of Human Resources.
