Stevens Institute of Technology is required to monitor whether or not a student is maintaining Title IV Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) in their course of study in compliance with federal regulations. Students who have been denied federal aid because they have not met the requirements for SAP are offered the opportunity to appeal for consideration of a one-semester financial aid probationary status.			
In some cases, a student's failure to be in compliance with SAP is due to unforeseen events beyond the student's control. If such extenuating circumstances can be documented, the student may complete the appeal process. Submission of an appeal does not guarantee reinstatement of financial aid eligibility. You are responsible for payment of tuition and fees regardless of your financial aid status. It is also your responsibility to be aware of all Stevens Institute of Technology's registration and payment deadlines.			
Appeal forms must be submitted to the Office of Financial Aid no later than <i>July 15, 2025,</i> for Fall 2025 and <i>January 13, 2026,</i> for Spring 2026 consideration.
