## A CHECKLIST OF APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Common Application
- ✓ Official high school transcript
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation
- ✓ \$70 USD application fee
- ✓ Test scores (test optional for Fall 2022 first-year applicants)

**If electing to submit test scores, at least one of the following standardized test options is required:**

- ✓ SAT I
- ✓ ACT
- ✓ Two AP exams: calculus and either chemistry or physics
- ✓ Two SAT subject tests: math and either chemistry or physics
- ✓ International Baccalaureate predicted grades with two higher-level exam scores in math and science

**If you are an international student applying to Stevens and English is not your first language, you must demonstrate English proficiency with one of the following:**

- ✓ TOEFL (minimum score of 80 iBT)
- ✓ IELTS (minimum score of 6 overall)
- ✓ SAT I Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (minimum score of 550)
- ✓ Duolingo English Test (minimum score of 105)
- ✓ Pearson PTE Academic Test (minimum score of 53)

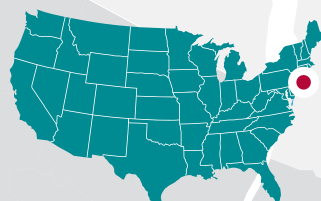
