- **1.** Non-Major Humanities Requirement Students must take HHS 130, HST 120, HLI 220, HPL 112 and two additional humanities in another HASS discipline outside of the student's major field.
- 2. Students are required are required to take math and science electives and can choose from MA 117 (Fall), MA 134, MA 236 (Spring), PEP 124 (Spring), PEP 151 (Spring), CH 115, BT 221 (Fall), BIO 281, HAR 271, or others. The advisor must approve the choice of classes.
- **3.** General Electives chosen by the student can be any approved 3 or 4 credit course used towards a minor, major concentration, research, independent study, language courses, or a course taken during an international experience.
- **4.** Literature Major Course requirements are as follows:
 - HLI 113 Classical Literature
 - HLI 114 Western Literature: Middle Ages to Present.
 - One course on a Major Author (e.g. Shakespeare)
 - Once course in America Literature (e.g. Colonial & Romantic American Literature)
 - One survey course from Classical to Renaissance or Elizabethan to Modern (e.g. 19th Century English Literature: Victorians)
 - One course in Modern Literature (e.g. Realist & Modern American Literature)
 - One course in Non-European Literature (e.g. Caribbean Literature & Culture)
 - An additional 5 major-area courses (HLI)
- **5.** Secondary Concentration: This can be chosen from all disciplines offered at Stevens upon consultation with your faculty advisor.
- **6.** Other Research Method classes determined with your advisor.
