

# STEM OPT Extension: Filing I-765 Online Guide

This guide is a useful tool for students applying for the STEM OPT Extension using the online application form with USCIS.

\*Please note that this guide is to help students with completing the Online I-765 Form with USCIS and should not be taken as legal advice.

\*\*It is very important that you do not submit your online I-765 Form without uploading your STEM OPT Requested I-20 from ISSS.

### **\*\***STEM OPT Applications must be submitted to USCIS within 60 days of the I-20 issuance date or before the Post-Completion OPT End Date listed on the EAD Card - whichever comes first.



## File a Form

Select the form you want to file online. Once you start, we will automatically save your information for 30 days, or from the last time you worked on the form.

Fee waiver: If you are requesting a fee waiver, you cannot file online. You must file a paper version of both the Form I-912, Request for Fee Waiver and the form for the specific benefit you are requesting. You can review the fee waiver guidance at www.uscis.gov/feewaiver.

- A Note: You may apply online if your eligibility category is:
  - · (a)(12) Temporary Protected Status (You are submitting an initial Form I-821 or you have an approved Form I-821);
  - (c)(3)(A) F-1 student, pre-completion OPT;
  - · (c)(3)(B) F-1 student, post-completion OPT;
  - · (c)(3)(C) F-1 student, 24-month extension for STEM students (students holding a degree in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics);
  - (c)(8) Applicants for Asylum under the ABC Settlement Agreement;
  - . (c)(8) Application for Employment Authorization Based on Pending Form I-589, Application for Asylum or for Withholding of Removal;
  - (c)(11) Parole;
  - · (c)(19) Temporary Protected Status (You have a pending Form I-821); or
  - (c)(33) Consideration of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) (You must have a pending or approved Form I-821D in order to file Form I-765).

All other applicants must submit a paper Form I-765

Important! Make sure you are selecting the correct type of Work Authorization you wish to apply for! TIP: Check page 2 of your I-20 to confirm the type of Work Authorization you are applying for.

(c)(3)(C) STEM Extension

Enter the degree for which you are requesting the STEM extension (Bachelor, Master, Doctorate, etc.)

Enter your employer's name as listed in E-Verify

Enter your employer's E-Verify Company Identification Number (usually 4-7 digits).

Please note that the E-Verify number is NOT the employer's EIN (9 digits) that was listed on the Form I-983.

### What is your A-Number?

I do not have or know my A-Number.

Provide a 7, 8, or 9-digit number. If your A-Number is fewer than 9 digits, the system will automatically add zero(s) after the "A" and before the first digit so there is a total of 9 digits, for example: A-001234567. Your A-Number is listed as the "USCIS #" on your EAD Card. Type it in this space. If you were issued more than one EAD card, enter A-Number listed on the most recent EAD card and provide all other numbers in Additional Information.

### What is your USCIS Online Account Number?

Providing your unique USCIS Online Account Number (OAN) helps us manage your account. You may already have an OAN if you previously filed <u>certain paper forms</u> and received an Account Access Notice in the mail. You can find the OAN at the top of the notice; it is not the same as an A-Number.

I do not have or know my USCIS Online Account Number.

Provide a 12-digit Online Account Number.

You will only have a USCIS Online Account number if you previously filed an application using the USCIS online filing system. If you did not, then this is left blank.

Answer "Yes" if you have been issued a Social Security Number (SSN).

If your I-20 has been issued more than 60 days prior to your payment/submission date, DO NOT SUBMIT & contact the ISSS Office for a new I-20!

Your STEM OPT Application <u>must be received by USCIS prior to the end date of your Post--Completion OPT!</u>
