Just earlier this week, Stevens was certified<sup>™</sup> by Great Place to Work® for the second consecutive year, with the satisfaction rate by colleagues increasing from 75% to 81%. I'm also proud to announce that the Undergraduate Class of 2023 Career Outcomes Report shows that 96.4% of graduates achieved their desired outcome — offers of employment or graduate school — within six months of graduation. These outcomes illustrate the excellence of our students and the value of a Stevens education.
