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To the Stevens Community:

As Stevens makes progress toward full restoration of IT systems across the university after the recent cyber-attack, we must simultaneously address some of the weaknesses that this incident revealed in our ability to conduct normal business operations in the immediate aftermath of the attack. While we may not encounter another emergency of this type, we must be prepared to conduct the business of our university in the face of a wide variety of unexpected circumstances.

To this end, I am pleased to announce a formal, institution-wide initiative to develop a Business Continuity Plan (BCP) for Stevens. The goals of this effort are:

- 1. to identify operational vulnerabilities, priorities, and dependencies across the university, and
- 2. to develop a documented plan—which will serve as a living and flexible framework—to ensure minimal disruption to key functions and rapid restoration of essential services in the aftermath of an emergency.
