

Acceptance of Program Requirements

- I understand that Stevens can only accept a limited number of students into the program and that I am not guaranteed acceptance.
- I must start and finish the course. If there are any concerns with failing or inability to attend I must notify the Dual Enrollment Assistant Director.
- I understand that the courses require homework that will need to be completed outside of class.
- I understand that a failing grade will be on an official Transcript at Stevens and may jeopardize your need for financial aid or studying at the college.
